


We give thanks to the Lord for bringing us to this momentous season once again; we have come to **40 Days of Power**. Our annual season of fasting, prayer and consecration continues to be a rallying point of spiritual emphasis for people all over the world.

The global pandemic has left many displaced in its wake. However, through divine providence, 40 Days of Power has come off unabated for the last two years. Prayer services went online affording ICGC churches and Christians all over the world the opportunity to fast and pray corporately with a united focus.

God's presence with us on this annual journey is further evidenced by the testimonies shared by people from all walks of life. Salvation, healing, deliverance and transformation are among the many manifestations of God's grace, mercy and power touching men, women and children.

40 Days of Power comes off from Thursday, 23rd June 2022 to Monday 1st August 2022. ICGC churches and Christians all over the globe will consecrate this 40-day period to the Lord to fast and pray for spiritual renewal and strength. We will pray on personal, family, church, national and global themes.

There will be online prayers every weekday from 5am to 1pm. This year, we return to having in-person evening services. From 6pm to 8pm, you can visit any ICGC assembly close to you and participate in the service being held there. A new introduction to this year's 40 Days of Power is the Late Night Prayer sessions to be organized every weekday night from 10pm to 11pm. This is to be carried online and it is going to be a time of intense intercession that brings each weekday's corporate prayers to a close. There will also be prayer services every Saturday morning to consolidate the week's prayer sessions.



This prayer guide has been thoughtfully put together help us pray effectively and expansively on different areas of need. There are weekly themes and daily sub-themes with scriptures to anchor our prayers. There are also scriptures for morning and evening reflections. The prayer segments are divided into consecration, guidance, protection, global missions, work and career and increase. There are also declarations with which to cap the prayers prayed in each segment. We believe that this guide will enrich your fasting and prayer experience.

As we fast, let us be mindful to do so wisely and healthily for physical and spiritual benefits. Included are some helpful tips on effective fasting that you will find helpful.

This is the year of Increase for the International Central Gospel Church. It is my prayer that as you use this guide and actively participate in 40 Days of Power, you will experience increase in every area of your life.

May the Lord hear your prayers and answer them speedily!

HELPFUL HINTS FOR FASTING

*The practice of regular fasting is a normal Christian behaviour taught by Jesus. In **Matthew 6:16–18**, Jesus provided guidelines for fasting. Fasting was also practiced by the early church as evidenced in **Acts 13:2**. It has been the regular discipline of believers throughout church history.*

Fasting has physical as well as spiritual benefits. It must be embarked on with spiritual commitment and wisdom. Everything should be done to the glory of God.

Do's Of Fasting

1. Prepare your body for the fast; cut back on food portions and eat smaller meals a few days prior to the fast.
2. Prevent constipation during and after the fast by eating fresh fruit and raw vegetables, fruit or vegetable juices, oatmeal, etc.
3. Drink lots of water when fasting.
4. Seek medical advice before the fast if you have any existing health conditions.
5. You can fast in many different ways. For example, a Daniel fast is one in which you consume only vegetables and water throughout. Pray and ask God what He will give you faith for the duration of the fast.
6. Have a clear target as your prayer focus. Without a vision or clear goal, the people perish. Write down your vision for the fast so you can run with it (**Habakkuk 2:2**).
7. Take time to pray and read the word. This may seem obvious, but busyness and distractions can keep you from daily devotions. Expect to hear God's voice in the word, dreams, visions, and revelations. Daniel prepared himself to receive revelation through fasting (**Daniel 10:1–2**).
8. Break your fast gradually. At this point you will need to exercise watchful self-control. Break your fast on a meal that is light and easy to digest (i.e., broth, a shredded apple, watermelon, or steamed vegetables).
9. Prepare for opposition. Satan tempted Jesus on the fast, and we must expect the same. Discouragement may come but take your stand on the victory of Christ.

Don'ts Of Fasting

1. Avoid high-fat and sugary foods before the fast.
2. Abstain from strong stimulants such as caffeinated and sugary drinks during a fast, including the artificial sweeteners found in diet drinks.
3. It is important after a fast to control your cravings and avoid overeating and nullifying the gains made during the fast.

I am excited that you are joining me on this fast. Commit to staying the course and fasting from the beginning to the end. I believe that God's glory will envelope our nation in a supernatural way as we wait upon the Lord.

DAY 5 - JUNE 27

Morning Reflection (5am - 9am)

1 Samuel 30:1-8

Now it happened, when David and his men came to Ziklag, on the third day, that the Amalekites had invaded the South and Ziklag, attacked Ziklag and burned it with fire, and had taken captive the women and those who were there, from small to great; they did not kill anyone, but carried them away and went their way. So David and his men came to the city, and there it was, burned with fire; and their wives, their sons, and their daughters had been taken captive. Then David and the people who were with him lifted up their voices and wept, until they had no more power to weep. And David's two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the widow of Nabal the Carmelite, had been taken captive. Now David was greatly distressed, for the people spoke of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and his daughters. But David strengthened himself in the LORD his God. Then David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, "Please bring the ephod here to me." And Abiathar brought the ephod to David. So David inquired of the LORD, saying, "Shall I pursue this troop? Shall I overtake them?" And He answered him, "Pursue, for you shall surely overtake them and without fail recover all."

Consecration

1. Thank God for the opportunity to come before Him today to receive strength and power for the months ahead.
2. Ask God to strengthen you to stand in every moment of distress and loss; affirm that all things shall work together for your good.
3. Pray for the commitment to abide in God's presence and teach you to hear His voice clearly.
4. Declare that you will hear the Lord's voice and obey every word that He speaks as you wait on Him today.

Guidance

5. Thank God for His promise to direct your path as you trust Him in all your ways.
6. Declare that you will not suffer any loss as you walk according to the leading of the Lord.
7. Ask the Lord to lead you by His Spirit and guide you in your daily choices.
8. Ask the Lord to surround you with people of sound counsel; thank Him for godly support as you deal with difficult issues in your life and family.
9. Receive divine strength to pursue, overtake and recover every lost dream and blessing in Jesus' name.

Protection

10. Thank God for His love and protection over your family; declare that by faith, your family will be victorious over every challenging situation in Jesus' name.
11. Cancel every evil plan of the enemy to steal, kill and destroy the members of your family; declare that you escape all plots in Jesus' name.
12. Ask the Lord to preserve the church and deliver her from every attack of the enemy; declare that the church will be established and the gates of hell will not prevail against her.

13. Thank God for giving you victory in all your endeavors; declare that you and your household will continue to walk in victory all the days of your life.
14. Celebrate your victory against every work of evil against your life, family, and the church; declare that you are preserved and protected all the days of your life.

Declaration

*My Spirit magnifies the Lord and my soul rejoices in God my savior. Thanks be to God who gives me access to His presence and protects me from all evil plots of darkness. As I wait on the Lord I receive strength and boldness to walk in the leading of the Lord and declare that the Lord answers me speedily as I come before Him in Jesus' name, **Amen.***

15. Thank God for all the Christian leaders he is raising to build and establish the church in these nations.
16. Release divine strength and power into the body of Christ in these nations to expand the work of soul-winning and discipleship among young people.
17. Come against every attack on churches in these nations and decree the Lord's protection and preservation.
18. By faith, declare a hundredfold restoration of every loss Christians in these nations have suffered because of their faith in Christ.
19. Intercede for missionaries and their families in these nations and ask the Lord to fill them with boldness and strength to pursue and win every lost soul.

Work and Career

20. Ask God for wisdom and insight to stay relevant in your field of work in these changing times.
21. Ask the Lord to stir up your faith to confront every difficult challenge in your life, relationship, marriage, education, or business; boldly claim every promise God has spoken concerning your situation in Jesus' name.
22. Ask the Lord to order your steps in the paths of righteousness in your pursuit of success and prosperity.
23. Pray for wisdom to rise above every limitation and take new territories in your career or business; boldly declare that the Lord will grant you abundant grace to prosper.
24. Ask God to strengthen your hands and accelerate your efforts as you embark on various plans in your life.

Increase

25. Thank the Lord for giving you breakthrough ideas that will move you to the next level of your life and ministry.
26. Declare that the Lord will make you and your family a thousand times more; decree that you will increase, expand and become great.
27. Declare a season of victory and recovery for all churches that have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

28. Declare that every member of the church will flourish and become strong in faith.
29. Pray that the Lord will prosper you abundantly even in seasons of difficulty and lack.

Declaration

*I declare that the Word of the Lord grows mightily and prevails in the nations. He honours His name in the life of all His servants who labour among the unsaved. No effort of mine will go unrewarded. I see the fruits of my labour and I decree that that the season of harvest is here. The Lord is my shepherd and I shall not want in Jesus's name, **Amen.***

Scripture for Reflection

Psalm 142:1-7

I cry out to the Lord with my voice; with my voice to the Lord I make my supplication. I pour out my complaint before Him; I declare before Him my trouble. When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then You knew my path. In the way in which I walk. They have secretly set a snare for me. Look on my right hand and see, for there is no one who acknowledges me; refuge has failed me; no one cares for my soul. I cried out to You, O Lord: I said, "You are my refuge, my portion in the land of the living. Attend to my cry, for I am brought very low; deliver me from my persecutors, for they are stronger than I. Bring my soul out of prison, that I may praise Your name; the righteous shall surround me, for You shall deal bountifully with me."

Declaration

*I thank the Lord whose ears are open to the cry of the righteous. I confess today that the God of David is my God and as he delivered his servant so has he also delivered me. My soul, spirit and body escapes all traps of the enemy. As I call on Him in this season, He answers me speedily and deals bountifully with me. By His counsel I walk in victory all the days of my life in Jesus' name, **Amen.***

DAY 6 - JUNE 28

Morning Reflection (5am - 9am)

1 Kings 17:1-10

And Elijah the Tishbite, of the inhabitants of Gilead, said to Ahab, “As the Lord God of Israel lives, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, except at my word.” Then the word of the Lord came to him, saying, “Get away from here and turn eastward, and hide by the Brook Cherith, which flows into the Jordan. And it will be that you shall drink from the brook, and I have commanded the ravens to feed you there.” So he went and did according to the word of the Lord, for he went and stayed by the Brook Cherith, which flows into the Jordan. The ravens brought him bread and meat in the morning, and bread and meat in the evening; and he drank from the brook. And it happened after a while that the brook dried up, because there had been no rain in the land. Then the word of the Lord came to him, saying, “Arise, go to Zarephath, which belongs to Sidon, and dwell there. See, I have commanded a widow there to provide for you.” So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, indeed a widow was there gathering sticks. And he called to her and said, “Please bring me a little water in a cup, that I may drink.”

Consecration

1. Give thanks to the Lord for being a Covenant Keeper; praise Him that He remains faithful to His word.
2. Search your heart and confess your sins to the Lord; ask for His forgiveness.
3. Ask the Holy Spirit to convict your heart and draw you to surrender your all to the Lord as you read the scriptures.
4. Ask the Lord to give you a teachable spirit; declare that you will desire to put God’s word first in all your dealings.

Guidance

5. Thank the Lord for His sure word that brings clarity and direction to your life.
6. Pull down every stronghold of unbelief and doubt that fights the manifestation of God’s word in your life.
7. Ask the Lord to lead you into His goodness; declare that you will enjoy every blessing of increase He has prepared for you this year.
8. Present the church to the Lord and ask Him to guide our leaders and members to accomplish every purpose concerning the church and their lives.
9. Pray that the principles in God’s word will guide the actions of governments around the world as they lead in building great nations to His glory.

Protection

10. Take authority over every tendency to walk by sight and not by faith; declare that your faith will not fail.
11. Reject every deception that entices you to exalt human wisdom over God’s wisdom.
12. Affirm God’s divine protection and preservation over every member of your household.

13. Come against every spirit of strife and confusion working against marriages in your family; claim love, unity, and the peace of God for all marriages in Jesus' name.
14. Thank the Lord for His covering over you; declare that disaster, plague, and evil shall be far from you and your dwelling place.

Declaration

The Word of the Lord cannot be broken. I receive God's Word into my life and I boldly declare that I walk daily by faith and not by sight. My faith will not fail because it is built on God's word that cannot fail. All eyes will see and give God glory for what God does in my life in Jesus' name, Amen.

19. Declare that sinners will come to the saving power of the word of God as it is preached in spirit and power.

Work and Career

20. Resist every negative thing that wants to stop you from reaching your goals in your career or business.
21. Come against tendencies towards regression in your work; declare that your season of advancement will not be cut short.
22. Pray that every obstacle in your way will be turned into a stepping stone for testimonies.
23. Pray for God's grace to be diligent and accountable for the favour and blessings on your life.
24. Prophesy by faith that as you manifest the abilities of God in you, unusual doors will be opened for you.

Increase

25. Pray that the Lord will prosper you abundantly and make you a channel of blessing to many.
26. Pray against every attitude that hinders spiritual growth in you; ask the Lord to help you to maintain your first love to serve as an inspiration to others.
27. Declare that every member of the church will flourish and become strong in faith; pray that no work of the adversary against their lives will prevail.
28. Present all Children, Youth, and Young Adults in the church to the Lord and ask Him to enable them uphold purity, sanctification, renewal of faith always.
29. Declare over your life that the Lord will bless you and keep you and make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you.

Declaration

*I confess today that I walk in abundance as I walk in the light of God's Word. I have insight, foresight and hindsight. Nothing will confuse me. Nothing will take me by surprise. God's word will accomplish all things in my life. The Lord increases me abundantly to be a blessing to others. I am a living testimony in Jesus' name. **Amen.***

Scripture for Reflection

Jeremiah 15:15-16

O Lord, You know; remember me and visit me, and take vengeance for me on my persecutors. In Your enduring patience, do not take me away. Know that for Your sake I have suffered rebuke. Your words were found, and I ate them, and Your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart; for I am called by Your name, O Lord God of hosts.

Declaration

*The Lord sustains all things by the Word of His power. I commit to daily study of His Word and I receive wisdom, understanding and the grace to walk in strong faith. I confess that as I keep and observe God's Word with my whole heart, I am led into prepared blessings this day and beyond in Jesus's name, **Amen.***

DAY 7 - JUNE 29

Morning Reflection (5am - 9am)

Acts 13:1-5

Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away. So, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went down to Seleucia, and from there they sailed to Cyprus. And when they arrived in Salamis, they preached the word of God in the synagogues of the Jews. They also had John as their assistant.

Consecration

1. Bless the Lord for the work of the Holy Spirit in the life all believers; thank Him for working in you both to will and to do of His good pleasure.
2. Surrender your thoughts and imaginations to God as you prayer and ask the Holy Spirit to cleanse your mind through God's Word.
3. Lift up your voice to the Lord to create in you a clean heart and renew a right spirit within you.
4. Pray for the wisdom to avoid acts of dishonor; declare that you will be a vessel of honor; sanctified and useful to God.

Guidance

5. Affirm the Lordship of Christ over your life and all that concerns you; declare that your ears are inclined to His Word for instruction and direction.
6. Declare that the Word of God will be a lamp to your feet and a light to your path in every step you take.
7. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you more and more into your life's purpose and help you lead a purposeful life.
8. Reject every ungodly council that seeks to direct you into any decision and lifestyle contrary to the leading of the Holy Spirit.
9. Pray that in this season, the Spirit of God will grant you illumination and understanding of the scriptures as you study God's Word day by day.

Protection

10. Reject any attack on your body, spirit and soul; declare that when the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of God shall lift up a standard against him.
11. Separate yourself and all that concerns you from sudden tragedy and misfortune; declare that the Spirit of the Lord shall lead you out of harm's way.

12. Renounce every negative confession you made about your life in a moment of pain, sorrow or confusion.
13. By faith, take back every possession which was lost through the pandemic; thank God for full restoration.
14. Resist every evil power at work against your family to steal your joy and peace; declare that the Lord surrounds you with protection as the mountains surround Jerusalem.

Declaration

I bless the Lord who is worthy to be praised. I praise the Lord for the blessing and gift of the Holy Spirit. I have a pure conscience towards the Lord. My prayers are divinely inspired to bring me to the place God has prepared for me. There will be no hindrance to my next level. In Jesus' name. Amen.

15. Pray against all forms of idolatry that opposes the growth of Christianity in these nations.
16. Pray for wisdom for Christian leaders in these nations with which to grow and establish the church in their lands.
17. Ask the Lord to renew the zeal of believers in these nations to share their faith.
18. Come against the agenda of the enemy to use media to fight against the efforts of the church.
19. Pray and overturn the passing of laws that seek to undermine worship of believers.

Work and Career

20. Ask the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to see the opportunities He is bringing your way to rise in your business.
21. Pray for the leading of the Holy Spirit to make right choices in your business deals and contracts.
22. Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you on your career path and enable you to become all that God wants you to be.
23. Affirm the promises of God concerning your finances; declare that you shall be a lender and not a borrower.
24. Declare that as you fast and pray in this season, you will receive great rewards for your labor.

Increase

25. Command everything that stands in opposition to God's increase in your life to be removed in Jesus name.
26. Affirm that the Holy Spirit is the executor of God's Word in your life; declare according to the word of the Lord that there shall be none barren in your land.
27. Pray for the direction of the Spirit to sow the right seeds for a harvest of blessing; declare that God will release the increase He has stored for you.
28. Declare that God is bringing His good thoughts concerning you to pass.
29. Pray that by the visitation of the Holy Spirit in your life, whatever is lacking in your life is filling up in Jesus name.

Declaration

*The name of the Lord is a strong tower. The righteous runs to it and are saved. I declare that the Church of God cannot be hidden. It will continue to offer hope to the hopeless, and direction to the lost. Through Jesus Christ, I'm more than a conqueror. Nothing will stop my increase this year. The Lord shall lead me besides the still waters. He shall restore my soul and I shall live fulfilled. In Jesus' name. **Amen.***

Scripture for Reflection

Romans 8:13-15

For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father."

Declaration

*I will call on the Lord at all times; His praises shall continually be in my mouth. I will meditate on His goodness in the night time and sing of His praises in the day time. The Lord has established His church and the gates of hell shall never prevail against it. I have all it takes to move forward in life. I take full control of my life and destiny, and I submit to the leading of the Holy Spirit. In Jesus' name, **Amen.***

DAY 8 - JUNE 30

Morning Reflection (5am - 9am)

Daniel 9:1-9

In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of the lineage of the Medes, who was made king over the realm of the Chaldeans— in the first year of his reign I, Daniel, understood by the books the number of the years specified by the word of the Lord through Jeremiah the prophet, that He would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem. Then I set my face toward the Lord God to make request by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes. And I prayed to the Lord my God, and made confession, and said, “O Lord, great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and mercy with those who love Him, and with those who keep His commandments, we have sinned and committed iniquity, we have done wickedly and rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and Your judgments. Neither have we heeded Your servants the prophets, who spoke in Your name to our kings and our princes, to our fathers and all the people of the land. O Lord, righteousness belongs to You, but to us shame of face, as it is this day—to the men of Judah, to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and all Israel, those near and those far off in all the countries to which you have driven them, because of the unfaithfulness which they have committed against You. “O Lord, to us belongs shame of face, to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, because we have sinned against You. To the Lord our God belong mercy and forgiveness, though we have rebelled against Him.

Consecration

1. Thank the Lord for counting you worthy to be among His chosen generation; commit your heart and mind to live a life of total devotion to Him.
2. Pray repenting of every hidden sin in your life and confess them to the Lord for forgiveness.
3. Ask the Father to reveal the character of Christ to you in His word; pray that you will live like Christ did.
4. Pray for spiritual strength to confront and overcome every weakness and desire of the flesh that hinders your spiritual growth.

Guidance

5. Surrender your will to the Lord, and declare that in all your ways you will acknowledge Him to direct your path.
6. Ask God to teach you the way you should go and guide your actions into His perfect will for your life.
7. Speak the word of the Lord over every disorder in your life; declare that the light from God's word will bring clarity in Jesus' name.
8. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you to pray accordingly to God's will as you persevere in prayer and fasting.
9. Pray for an obedient heart for God's word; declare that you will meditate on God's word day and night and observe to do all that is written in it.

Protection

10. Declare the covering of the Lord over your life; stand against every obstacle delaying the manifestation of God's promises concerning your life and family.
11. Confess according to God's Word, that you will live and not die to declare the works of the Lord; rebuke every voice contrary to this truth in Jesus' name.
12. Break the cycles of bondage and generational curses in your life and family; declare that the blessings of Christ will prevail.
13. Ask the Lord to guard your heart and mind with His Word and protect you from fear, anxiety and unbelief.
14. Pray that God will surround your children with people who will inspire them to greatness; ask Him to deliver them from wrong association and evil company.

Declaration

I will worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness. I will lift up prayer on His holy hill. I commit myself to pure devotion towards Him. His word shall be a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. 1 Samuel 3:1-10

Now the boy Samuel ministered to the Lord before Eli. And the word of the Lord was rare in those days; there was no widespread revelation. And it came to pass at that time, while Eli was lying down in his place, and when his eyes had begun to grow so dim that he could not see, and before the lamp of God went out in the tabernacle of the Lord where the ark of God was, and while Samuel was lying down, that the Lord called Samuel. And he answered, "Here I am!" So he ran to Eli and said, "Here I am, for you called me." And he said, "I did not call; lie down again." And he went and lay down. Then the Lord called yet again, "Samuel!" So Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you called me." He answered, "I did not call, my son; lie down again." (Now Samuel did not yet know the Lord, nor was the word of the Lord yet revealed to him.) And the Lord called Samuel again the third time. So he arose and went to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you did call me." Then Eli perceived that the Lord had called the boy. Therefore Eli said to Samuel, "Go, lie down; and it shall be, if He calls you, that you must say, 'Speak, Lord, for Your servant hears.'" So Samuel went and lay down in his place. Now the Lord came and stood and called as at other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel answered, "Speak, for Your servant hears."

Consecration
